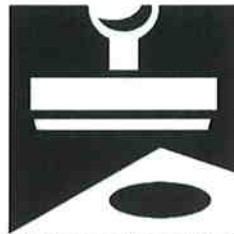


Second Quarter Water Bills

Please take note that the second quarter water bills will be mailed to all water customers at the beginning of July and are due July 31st. Should any resident pay their water bill after the due date, the resident must pay the **"Pay After Due Date"** amount as reflected on the invoice to avoid any further late fees. Late fees are calculated on any and all past due balances and is **10%** of that balance. In addition, if you are not receiving your quarterly water bills, please contact the Borough Office immediately at (724) 776-3090. No exoneration is given for failure to receive a bill.

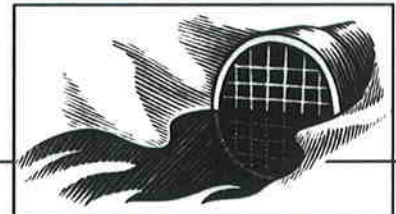
Parking Reminder

There have been concerns from residents regarding vehicles being parked half on the sidewalk and half on the road and on the street for extended periods of time. Please note, on street parking is allowed with the exception of the hours between 2:00 a.m.—6:00 a.m. Residents should contact 911 if they see vehicles parked during this time.



Grass Dumping Prohibited

Residents are again asked to refrain from dumping grass clippings in drainage swales and catch basins. Grass clippings and leaves prevent the proper flow of water in these areas and can create severe drainage problems, not to mention increasing the cost of maintenance. With all the rain we have received so far in 2010, we're all too familiar with the repercussions when there are drainage problems!





Emergency Call List

For those of you new in the Borough or those of you who may not have been aware, Seven Fields Borough has a community safety Reverse 911 System in place from OneCall Now for emergency notifications to Seven Fields residents. Since communication is done through phone messaging, in order for residents of the borough to receive any emergency alerts or notices, you must register your phone number with the borough. Chloramines—For Your Info

As we've reported, West View Water has been using chloramine disinfection. Chloramines have been used safely in the US and Canada for eight years. Most customers will not notice a difference in their water supply and here are a couple of facts you should note:



- ◆ Chloraminated water is safe for bathing, drinking, cooking and all normal uses.
- ◆ Chloramines must be removed from water prior to dialysis treatment and from water used in aquariums, fish ponds and terrariums.
- ◆ Patients using home dialysis treatment should check with their equipment providers to obtain the proper equipment to remove chloramines.
- ◆ Chloramine neutralizers can be purchased at pet stores for use in aquariums, fish ponds and terrariums.

Reminder for Dog Walkers & Pedestrians

Residents are reminded that Ordinance #40 mandates that pet owners must pick up their dog feces when walking their dogs through the community. Please note that pets are NOT permitted in the Towne Park—this includes the entire park—playground, pool, ball fields, etc. Not only is it a violation against Ordinance #40, it is also a safety hazard for children playing in the playground area. Individuals are encouraged to report offenders to the Borough office.

With the arrival of summer comes an increase in the number of joggers and walkers in the community. For safety sake, joggers and walkers are asked to utilize the sidewalks and not the streets when out getting their exercise. We are fortunate in Seven Fields to have a lot of sidewalks to utilize for walking and jogging in the community!





AUTHORIZATION FOR AUTOMATIC PAYMENT WITHDRAWAL (ACH) FOR QUARTERLY WATER PAYMENTS

Thank you for requesting automatic payment withdrawal for your water account. Quarterly Water Payments will be withdrawn from your bank checking or savings account automatically within 5 to 7 business days prior to the due date. Please allow thirty (30) days following receipt of this authorization form for processing. Continue to pay your bill as usual until you are notified in writing that your application has been processed. ANY CHANGES TO OR DISCONTINUATION OF THIS WITHDRAWAL SCHEDULE MUST BE REQUESTED AT LEAST FIFTEEN (15) WORKING DAYS PRIOR TO THE END OF THE BILLING QUARTER AND MUST BE MADE IN WRITING. If there are insufficient funds in your account to complete the withdrawal, there will be a \$35 fee assessed to cover our bank charges.

*A separate authorization agreement must be completed for each water account that automatic payment withdrawal is requested.
