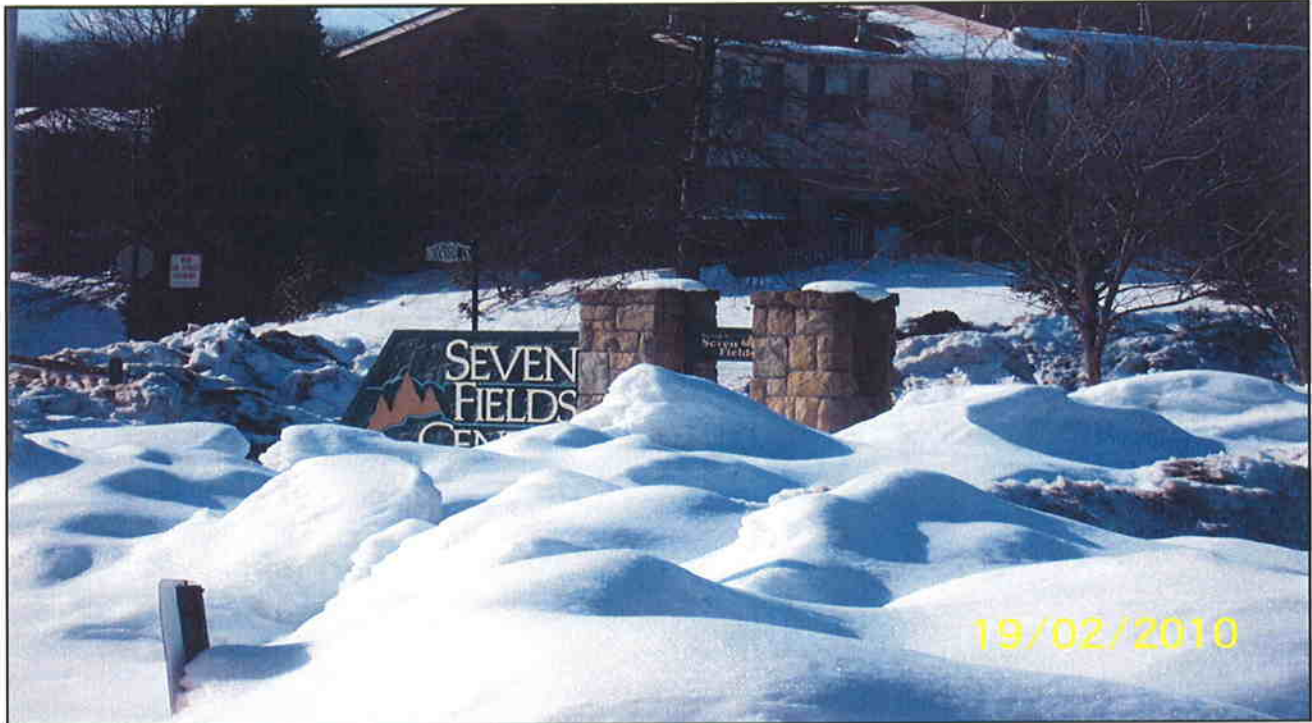


## Storm of 2010

### POOL MANAGER AND LIFEGUARDS NEEDED

With temperatures approaching the freezing mark, it may be hard to believe that the Borough is already beginning preparations for the 2010 Towne Park Pool season. The Borough is currently accepting applications for the pool manager's position, (a seasonal position beginning in May through the beginning of September). The pool manager oversees the day-to-day operations of the pool, including supervising the lifeguard staff, scheduling staff, ordering inventory for the concession stand, overseeing the monitoring of pool chemistry, cleanliness and equipment, etc. The Borough is looking for a mature individual with excellent organizational skills, the ability to manage and motivate young people and the ability to communicate with the public. Applicants must have current Red Cross lifeguard, first aid and CPR certifications or obtain them prior to the opening of the pool. This is a great opportunity for someone to enjoy some time in the sun while earning a paycheck this summer. Interested individuals should complete an employment application at the Borough Office (or online at [www.sevenfields.org](http://www.sevenfields.org)) by March 19th and questions may be directed to Thomas B. Smith, Borough Manager, at (724) 776-3090.

The Borough is also accepting lifeguard applications. To encourage Seven Fields residents to become lifeguards and work at the Towne Park Pool for the complete 2010 season, committing themselves to working a minimum of 25 hours a week, the Borough will reimburse the scholarship recipients the cost of their certification at the end of the season. Residents interested in a lifeguard position at the Towne Park Pool, especially those interested in the scholarship program, are asked to complete an employment application (available at the Borough Office or on-line at [www.sevenfields.org](http://www.sevenfields.org)) as soon as possible.

## Council Corner

### February 8th Council Meeting

- ◆ Borough Council approved the 2010 Municipal Surrender Contract with Butler County. This agreement will provide for the pick-up of stray animals within the Borough.
- ◆ Resolution 2010-11 was approved for the Borough to submit a grant application to the Butler County Parks Renovation Community Grant Program.
- ◆ Borough Manager Tom Smith provided Council with additional information about the carnival company coming in May. A few items were the addition of a live band, Rudy & The Professionals, and fireworks from Zambelli.
- ◆ Borough Manager Tom Smith updated Council on the progress of the Towne Park renovations and advised the playground equipment is on order.
- ◆ Borough Council approved the advertisement for lifeguards to staff the community pool this summer.
- ◆ Borough Council approved the application to the state for a grant in the 2010-2011 US House of Representatives Appropriations program.
- ◆ Borough Council approved the 2010-2011 Traffic Signal Maintenance Agreement with Cranberry Township.

## Seven Fields Burning Ordinance

Residents are reminded that Ordinance No. 16 stipulates that open burning and incineration within the Borough is prohibited. This includes the burning of leaves and trash, etc. However, recreational fires are permitted and require a permit issued through the Borough Office. The permit is free and is good for two weeks. Any person who violates any provision of the Ordinance shall upon conviction, be fined not less than \$50.00 for the first violation, and not less than \$50.00, or more than \$300.00 for the second and succeeding violations.

## Dog Licenses

2010 dog licenses are now available at the Seven Fields Borough Office, the Cranberry Township Public Library (2525 Rochester Road), and Mars Public Library (107 Grand Avenue) for \$8.50 or \$6.50, depending on if your dog is spayed/neutered. All dogs three (3) months and older are required to have a valid Butler County dog license. Animal Control Officers started patrolling for proof of licenses in February, so don't delay!

## **\$1000 College Scholarship Offered**

The Pennsylvania State Borough's Association is offering the Robert C. Edwards Scholarship to qualified Seven Fields residents. Applicants must be accepted for admission to an accredited college, university or school which offers a two (2) or four (4) year degree/certificate program. The scholarship is for the first year (freshman) at the college, university or school. The applicant must attach a picture which may be used for publicity purposes, and will not be returned. In addition to a high school transcript, letters of recommendation, and other documents, applicants must submit a brief essay explaining why they want to further their education and what they expect from attending college.

Applications must be post-marked no later than May 4th. Scholarship winners will be selected by an independent panel of retired school officials approved by the Foundation Board of Directors.
