Evans City/Seven Fields Regional Police Department

The June months-end report provided to Council at the meeting on Monday, July 13, 2015 revealed 138 calls and 38 citations written within Seven Fields Borough.

Please note that police activity is generated by resident concerns via emails, phone calls, council members, etc. They are not driven for revenue generation.

A verification form must be submitted to the Borough Office by the family for the Nanny Pass to be issued. The Nanny Pass will only be issued to bona fide babysitters and are only permitted pool access when accompanied by the children for whom they have registered with the Borough that they baby sit.

Ordinance #66

Section VI. Trimming of Trees and Other Plants Along and Above Sidewalks

...it is the duty of occupants and owners at all times to keep hedges, bushes, shrubbery and trees trimmed as not to obstruct the sidewalk...or the view of motorists along intersecting streets...limbs of trees shall be deemed an obstruction if they are permitted to overhang the sidewalk at a **height of less than seven (7) feet...**

Borough Officials are actively enforcing the Ordinance. Take the necessary steps to be aware and be compliant—avoid the fine.

Seven Fields Burning Ordinance

Residents are reminded that Ordinance No. 16 stipulates that open burning and incineration within the Borough is prohibited. This includes the burning of leaves and trash, etc.

Recreational fires are permitted but require a permit issued through the Borough Office. The "Recreational Campfire Permit" form is available online or at the Borough Office. The permit is free and is valid for two weeks.

Any person who violates any provisions of the Ordinance shall upon conviction, be fined not less than \$50.00 for the first violation, and not less than \$50.00, or more than \$300.00 for the second and succeeding violations.


