**VOLUNTEER NEEDED
EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT COORDINATOR**

The Borough is currently seeking a volunteer to serve as the Emergency Management Coordinator (EMC). The responsibilities and functions of the EMC are listed below and require actions which are common to all types of major emergencies or disasters, (i.e. dangerous storms, hazardous materials accidents, nuclear incidents).

- A. Prepare, maintain and keep current a disaster emergency operations plan for the prevention and minimization of injury and damage caused by a major emergency or disaster, prompt and effective response to a major emergency or disaster and emergency relief and recovery in consonance with the Butler County Emergency Management Plan.
- B. Initiate and maintain coordination and cooperation with the Butler County Emergency Management Agency (BCEMA), and provide prompt information as requested.
- C. Identify hazards that may affect the municipality. In coordination with the Butler County Emergency Management Agency (BCEMA) and based upon its Hazards Vulnerability Analysis, determine what hazards could potentially impact upon the Borough.
- D. Identify resources within the municipality that can be used to respond in a major emergency or disaster situation and report "unmet" needs. This should include both public and private resources and mass care facilities.
- E. Develop and maintain an emergency management organization and a trained staff appropriate for the needs and resources of Seven Fields Borough. The staff must be capable of maintaining 24 hour operations.
- F. Mobilize, direct and coordinate the emergency management staff during an emergency.
- G. Develop standard operating procedures (SOP) in coordination with the staff to carry out their responsibilities and functions and the functions of the Emergency Operations Center.

SEVEN FIELDS TOWN PARK ICE RINK

The Public Works Department is working hard to prepare the ice rink for the skating season. The rink will be open to the public and is first come first serve. Skaters are asked to be courteous to others and take turns on the ice. Skate at your own risk. Helmets and gloves are recommended. Skaters under 12 years of age must be accompanied by an adult.

The rink has a plastic liner and will be filled with water when the temperature hits freezing. The ice will take approximately 5 to 7 days to set. As we begin to start making the ice for the rink, it is **EXTREMELY** important that no one step on the ice until it is fully frozen. When signs are posted that the ice rink is **CLOSED**, please do not attempt to skate on it. If someone steps on the ice before it is ready, the liner will rip and this will delay the opening of the ice rink for an indefinite period of time.

Residents will be notified through our Code Red phone system when the rink is open and ready to be used.

PLEASE HELP KEEP YOUR ICE RINK SAFE AND ENJOYABLE
BY OBSERVING THE FOLLOWING:

- **WARNING:** This is an unsupervised facility, use at your own risk. Ice skating is a hazardous recreational activity which can result in serious injury, broken bones, brain damage, paralysis or even death. The Borough of Seven Fields does not assume any responsibility for damage or injuries resulting from the use of this facility.
- Only ice skaters are allowed on the ice. (No shoes or boots are permitted.)
- Helmets and gloves are recommended.
- Skaters under the age of 12 must be accompanied by an on-site guardian.
- Unsafe or reckless behavior is not allowed.
- Noise is to be kept to a minimum. Amplified sound, organized events or sales of any kind are not permitted.
- Ice rink is to be used on a first-come, first-served basis. Do not use the park if it is too crowded for you to skate safely. Skaters must take turns and respect other skaters.
- Glass is not allowed. Drinking or eating on the skating surface is not permitted
- Additional obstacles or other materials (ramps/jumps) are not allowed.
- All park rules apply.
- Do not use the ice rink if the ice is melted. Damage to the liner will occur.
- Depending on conditions, surface may be rutted.
- Report any illegal activity, including vandalism and graffiti, to the Police. In case of emergency, call 911.



Snow Shovelers Wanted

Winter Mailbox Damage

The Borough of Seven Fields will not repair or replace mailboxes or posts that are damaged or fall over from the force of plowed snow and are not hit directly by the plow.

Mailboxes and supporting posts must be strong enough and installed in such a way to withstand the weight and force of snow removal including the force of snow pushed from the streets onto the side of the road.

Contact the Borough Office if you have a damaged mailbox and the Public Works Supervisor will investigate.

SNOW AND ICE REMOVAL FROM SIDEWALKS

As winter is fast approaching and snowfall is unpredictable it's important to be prepared. Working together we can keep our community safe.

Ordinance #66, Section II outlines the requirements for snow & ice to be removed from sidewalks. Noncompliance will result in a warning notice, in accordance with **Ordinance #81**, being issued including a \$25 administrative fee.

The owner, occupant or tenant of every property fronting upon or located alongside any street in the Borough of Seven Fields is hereby required to remove or cause to be removed from all the sidewalks abutting upon such property, all snow or ice thereon fallen or formed.

Within twenty-four (24) hours after the snow shall have ceased to fallen or to have formed.

The snow and ice removed from the sidewalk shall not be dumped or piled onto any public street or alley.




