Council met on Monday, February 9, 2015 and approved the following:

- Submission of the Butler County Park Renovation Grant Application in the amount of \$10,000 (Northridge Park Rubberized Safety Surface)
- Youngblood Paving, Inc. bid of \$182,000 for the 2015 Road Resurfacing Program
- Steel City Flooring bid of \$7,600 to install flooring on the 2nd floor in the leased offices of the Municipal Building
- Updated Seven Fields Personnel Manual
- Hiring of Lynda Smith as the Pool Manager for 2015 (This is Lynda's 3rd year as Pool Manager.)
- Hiring of Thomas Cordell as the full-time skilled laborer for the Public Works Department

Winter Mailbox Damage



The Borough of Seven Fields will not repair or replace mailboxes or posts that are damaged or fall over from the force of plowed snow and are not hit directly by the plow.

Mailboxes and supporting posts must be strong enough and installed in such a way to withstand the weight and force of snow removal including the force of snow pushed from the streets onto the side of the road.

Meet K-9 Officer Chaos



Chaos is a German Shepherd, born in Yugoslavia and trained at Castle K-9. He joined the police force in 2007 after the retirement of K-9 Officer Rex, Evans City's first K-9 Officer.

Sergeant Donald Myers has been partnered with Chaos since August 2007. They are certified through North American Police Work Dog Association (NAPWDA) for narcotics and patrol. Over their 7 years of service together they have assisted with patrol, numerous narcotics detections, tracked and assisted with the apprehension of criminals throughout Butler and the surrounding counties.

"Patrol" covers—tracking, building searches, area searches for fleeing actors, apprehension work, handler protection and article searches.

"Narcotics" covers—Marijuana, Meth, Heroin and Cocaine

Sergeant Myers and Chaos have been used by local, state and federal agencies for everything from bank robberies, package searches for drugs, fugitive warrants and apprehensions, missing children, suicidal subjects, elderly walk offs and more.



They provide demonstrations for local organizations, Pennsylvania State Police Cadet Camp, schools and community events. They assist with school searches for drugs not only to locate narcotics in the schools but also to deter the drug dealing or possession on school properties.




K-9 Officers have undoubtedly and statistically deterred criminal elements from considering a community as a target.


