

BOROUGH OF SEVEN FIELDS
ORDINANCE #18

An Ordinance to establish standards of visibility for public safety equipment.

SECTION 1. Public safety equipment is defined as follows:

- * fire hydrants
- * police phone boxes
- * fire alarm boxes
- * crossing signal activators
- * speed bumps
- * any other equipment or fixture intended to insure public safety

SECTION 2. All of the equipment or fixtures set forth in Section 1 above must be painted with a high-visibility safety yellow paint.

SECTION 3. Every item so designated must be inspected and repainted on a regular basis to ensure that the brightness is maintained at all times.

SECTION 4. Grass, shrubbery, snow, or any other materials within a five (5) foot radius of said equipment or fixtures must be kept neatly trimmed or cleared at all times to allow easy visibility.

SECTION 5. The responsibility for compliance with this Ordinance lies with the person or organization responsible for said installation and maintenance of said equipment, or the owner of said equipment and fixtures.

SECTION 6. Non-compliance with this Ordinance will result in action by the Borough Council to meet the standards set by the Ordinance.

SECTION 7. Any expenses incurred by Council in complying with the requirements of this Ordinance will be billed to the responsible parties as set forth in Section 5, for the total amount plus a fine of 15% of that total, said fine upon conviction not to exceed \$300.00 dollars.
