NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF SEVEN FIELDS, BUTLER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA:

Section 3. Section 3 of Ordinance No. 59 shall be amended to read as follow:

ORDINANCE NO. 59

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF SEVEN FIELDS,
COUNTY OF BUTLER, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA,
AND ESTABLISHING THE TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES AT
DESIGNATED INTERSECTIONS OF PUBLICLY DEDICATED
AND ACCEPTED STREETS WITHIN THE BOROUGH.

WHEREAS, the Borough of Seven Fields, pursuant to Resolution
Number 97-15, has accepted the public dedication and transfer in
ownership to the Borough of the streets as set forth in said
ordinance; and

WHEREAS, traffic control devices have previously been
erected at various intersection of said public roads; and

WHEREAS, the borough desires to accept and maintain said
traffic control devices; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ordinance #46 the Borough wishes to
establish by ordinance said traffic control devices to provide for
their enforcement,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND
ENACTED BY THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF THE
BOROUGH OF SEVEN FIELDS, BUTLER COUNTY,
PENNSYLVANIA:

Section 1. That the traffic control devices as set forth in section
3 of this ordinance, shall be and hereby are adopted by the Borough
pursuant to the applicable sections of the Borough Code, and 75 PA
CSA 101 et. seq. (Hereinafter "Title 75"), as amended.

Section 2. That the borough is authorized to erect traffic control devices pursuant to 75 PA CSA Section 6122 as the Borough has a qualified traffic engineer.

Section 3. That the following traffic control devices are hereby adopted by the Borough:

A. Stop Signs:

1. Castle Creek Drive/Saxony Drive
2. Castle Creek Drive/Cumberland Drive (3-way stop)
3. Castle Creek Drive/Warrick Dr./Wilshire Circle (4-way stop)
4. Castle Creek Drive/Woodhaven Drive (west - 3-way stop)
5. Castle Creek Drive/Woodhaven Drive (east)
6. Castle Creek Drive/Brookside Lane
7. Castle Creek Drive/Covington Court
8. Castle Creek Drive/Forest Drive
9. Saxony Drive/Wellington Drive (2-way stop)
10. Warrick Drive/Blackburn Court
11. Warrick Drive/Hampton Court
12. Cumberland Drive/Strathmore Court (3-way stop)
13. Cumberland Drive/Franklin Road
14. Cumberland Drive/Westburn Court

Section 4. Enforcement of the said traffic control devices will be by the duly appointed police department of the borough, pursuant to the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania traffic rules and regulations, as set forth in Title 75, as amended, and as established by the rules and regulations of the Department of Motor Vehicles.

Section 5. Penalties Penalties for violation of the adopted traffic control devices shall be as set forth in Title 75, as amended.

Section 6. Severability. If any section, clause, or part of this ordinance, for any reason found to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality or invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, sections or parts of the ordinance. It is hereby declared as the intent of the Council of the Borough of Seven Fields, that this ordinance would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal or invalid sentence, clause, section or part thereof not be

Section 7. Effective date this ordinance shall be effective as the 8th day of December, 1997,
