ORDINANCE #2

An ordinance of the Borough of Seven Fields, County of Butler, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania to establish borough security and safety.

Section 1. This ordinance will be known as the ordinance for borough police and security protection.

Section 2. The council government of the Borough of Seven Fields shall seek to provide police protection and law enforcement for all residents of the borough.

Section 3. The council government of the Borough of Seven Fields shall have exclusive privilege to acknowledge, certify or permit the establishment of any police, security, or law enforcement agency within the bounds of the borough.

AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE #2
