

BOROUGH OF SEVEN FIELDS
ORDINANCE NO. 37 (AS AMENDED)

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF SEVEN FIELDS, BUTLER COUNTY, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, ESTABLISHING A FEE FOR THE REPLACEMENT OF RECYCLING BINS.

Section I

The Borough of Seven Fields is, pursuant to laws and regulations of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and Ordinance No. 33 of the Borough of Seven Fields, mandating recycling within the Borough.

Section II

Pursuant to Ordinance No. 33, recycling bins were provided free of charge to all residential units of the Borough. Ordinance No. 33 provides only for the provision by the Borough of the first recycling bin to each residential unit for free, and requires that all replacement bins be charged for.

Section III

If a recycling bin must be replaced, the Borough will provide one for a fee of \$5.00, payable by the property owner.
