COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, COUNTY OF BUTLER BOROUGH OF SEVEN FIELDS ORDINANCE NO. 76

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE BOROUGH OF SEVEN FIELDS AND CRANBERRY TOWNSHIP FOR THE PROVISION OF POLICE SERVICES TO THE BOROUGH OF SEVEN FIELDS.

The Borough Council of the Borough of Seven Fields, County of Butler, and Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, does ordain as follows:

SECTION 1: Pursuant to the Intergovernmental Cooperation Act, No. 180, 53 P.S. Section 481 et seq., the terms and conditions of the Agreement between the Borough of Seven Fields and Cranberry Township for police protection dated the 11 day of May, 2009, attached hereto and made a part hereof, are hereby adopted.

SECTION 2: The Agreement between the Borough of Seven Fields and Cranberry Township for police protection shall become effective the date specified in said agreement and when adopted by ordinance validly enacted by the Borough of Seven Fields and Cranberry Township.

SECTION 3: The provisions of this ordinance shall be severable. If a final decision of a Court of Competent Jurisdiction shall hold any provisions of this ordinance, or the application thereof to any circumstances, to be illegal or unconstitutional, all other provisions of the ordinance and its application shall remain in full force and effect. It is hereby declared by legislative intent that this ordinance would have been enacted had such unconstitutional, invalid, or illegal portion not been included.
