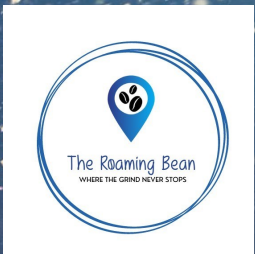

2024 Seven Fields Budgets-Borough Council approved the 2024 Budgets. The Legal Notice and 10-day Inspection Period requirements had been met.

Legal Ad Ordinance No. 9 (2024 Seven Fields Millage Rate)-Borough Council authorized the Legal Advertisement for Ordinance No. 9 that establishes the 2024 millage rate at 7 mills.

Legal Ad for 2024 Council Meeting Dates (Resolution No. 2023-20)-Borough Council approved the legal advertisement to advertise the 2024 Regular Meeting dates and times for Borough Council Meetings.

Legal Ad for 2024 Planning Commission Dates (Resolution No. 2023-21)-Borough Council approved the legal advertisement to advertise the 2024 meeting dates and times for the Planning Commission Meetings.

Municibid Ad-2012 Exmark Lawn Mower -Borough Council authorized selling the 2012 Exmark Lawn Mower on Municibid.

Resolution No. 2023-22 (Disposition of Metal Bleachers from Seven Fields Soccer Field)-Borough Council approved Resolution No. 2023-22, the scrapping of broken metal bleachers removed from the Seven fields Soccer Field.

Resolution No. 2023-23 (Community Center Non-Profit Rates)-Borough Council approved Resolution No. 2023-23, increasing the Community Center Rates for Non-Profit Organizations to a flat rate of \$65 per hr. with a 2 hr. minimum.

Resolution No. 2023-24 (Community Center Resident/Non-Resident Rates)-Borough Council approved Resolution No. 2023-24, increasing the Community Center Resident rate to \$65 per hr. weekdays and \$75 per hr. Friday after 4pm, Saturday, and Sunday with a 2 hr. minimum. Non-Resident rate increasing to \$90 per hr. weekdays and \$100 per hr. Friday after 4pm, Saturday, and Sunday with a 2 hr. minimum.

Seven Fields Water Company 2024 Residential Water Meter Purchase-Borough Council approved the quote provided by EAP Industries, Inc. in the amount of \$24,336 for 78 Residential Water Meters as part of the Seven Fields Meter Replacement Program. To be paid out of 2024 Budget.

Seven Fields Water Company 2024 Commercial Water Meter Purchase-Borough Council approved the quote provided by EAP Industries, Inc. in the amount of \$3,762 for Commercial Water Meters to be paid out of 2024 Budget.

Seven Fields Water Company 2023 Water Curb Boxes & Valves Purchase-Borough Council approved the quotes provided by LB Water Services in the amount of \$5,697 for water curb boxes and quote in the amount of \$19,027 for valves. The Water Company capital Reserve Budget allocated \$45K for these purchases.

Seven Fields Public Works 2024 Equipment Deposit-Borough Council authorized a down payment in the amount of \$1,500 on a commercial grade Cub Cadet ProZ960s 60 inch with bagger unit & quickchute. The total amount will be \$15,950 under Sourcewell pricing and paid in January to J&D Lawn & Tractor.

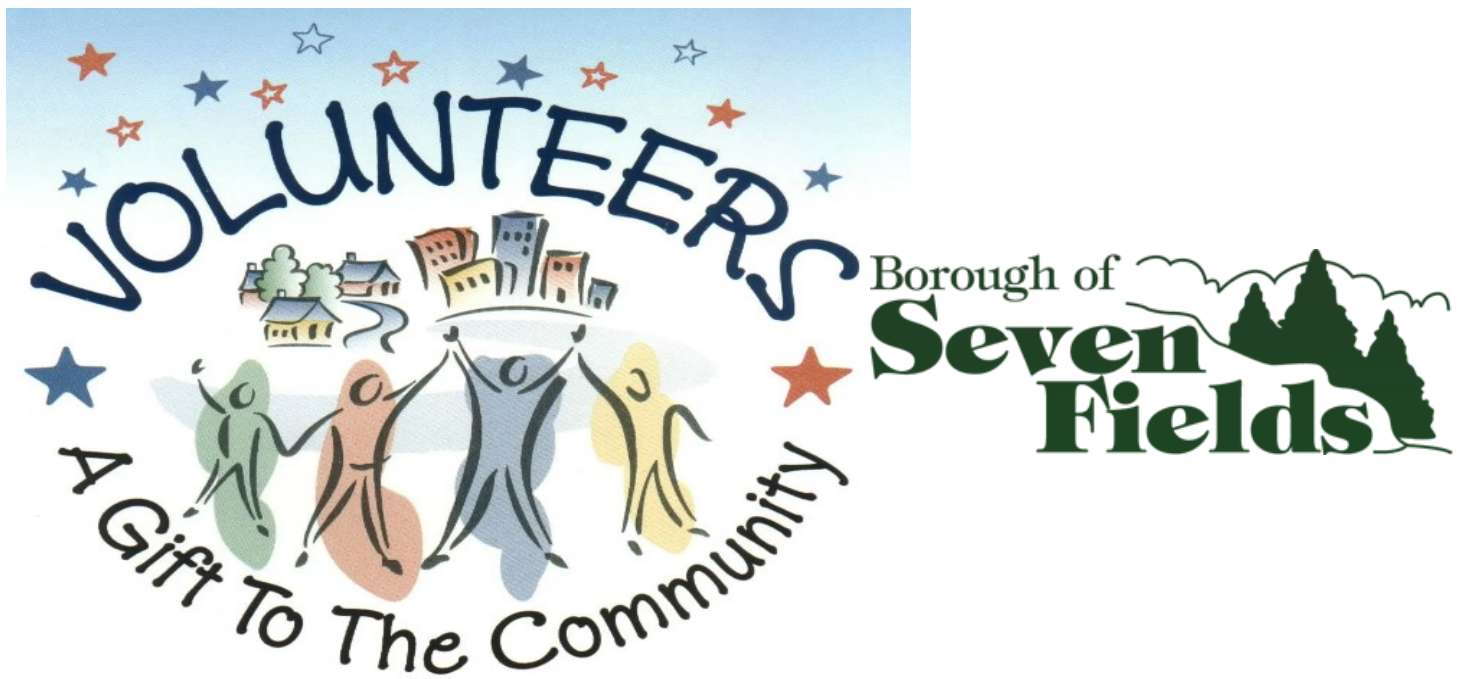
Our new FIBER-OPTIC network will offer many benefits to you including:

Remember: Just because it is made of a material that can be recycled, doesn't mean the item can be recycled by our Company.

**Glass will be collected in your recycling cart from your municipality to be repurposed for another use.*

RECYCLING REMINDERS

- 1) Set out blue lid recycling carts the night before your scheduled day. Place within 5-ft of curb or roadside.
- 2) Cart lids must be closed with opening to street side.
- 3) Recyclables that are mixed with garbage will not be collected. Place in trash the following week.
