



AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE  
NUMBER #4

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF SEVEN FIELDS COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF SEVEN FIELDS, COUNTY OF BUTLER, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA TO AMEND ORDINANCE NUMBER 4 DATED JANUARY 3, 1984 AND IT'S PREVIOUS AMENDMENT DATED JANUARY 30, 1984 AND IT'S AMENDMENT DATED MAY 14, 1984 TO ADD THE FOLLOWING:

WHEREAS, the Borough Council of the Borough of Seven Fields has found that it is in the best interest of the safety of the public that only grades K copper tubing for underground installations and L copper tubing for above ground installations be used and installed for the distribution of water in all construction in the Borough of Seven Fields, and that only compression fittings be used for underground copper water tube installations in the Borough of Seven Fields.


THEREFORE, Section 404.1 through 404.6 of the BOCA code will be amended by this Ordinance to require the use of K and L copper tubing and compression fittings as set forth here and above and this amendment to Ordinance #4 shall be an amendment to an exception from the standard terms of the BOCA code as adopted.

ORDINANCE #4

An ordinance of the Borough of Seven Fields, County of Butler, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, establishing borough codes.

Section 1. The borough shall adopt the most current Building Officials & Code Administrators (known as BOCA) codes for borough regulation.

1. The BOCA codes shall be used for building codes.
2. The BOCA fire codes shall be used to establish borough fire safety.
3. The BOCA codes book One and Two Family Dwellings will also be adopted for residential dwellings.

Section 2. The borough council shall have the privilege to amend any and all of these codes as deemed necessary.
