ORDINANCE #3

An ordinance of the Borough of Seven Fields, County of Butler, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, to establish borough fire and ambulance protection.

Section 1. The council government of the Borough of Seven Fields shall seek to provide fire protection service and ambulance service for all residents of the borough.

Section 2. The council government of the Borough of Seven Fields shall have exclusive privilege to acknowledge, certify or permit the establishment of any fire protection agency, group or department, volunteer or professional within the bounds of the borough.


