2020 Census FAQ

What is the census?

The census is a count of every person who lives in the United States and its territories. It happens every 10 years. In early 2020, you will be asked to count everyone who lives in your home as of April 1. Responding to the 2020 Census is a chance to shape your future.

What's In It for me?



Your responses inform where over \$675 billion is distributed each year to communities nationwide for clinics, schools, roads, and more.



Census data gives community leaders vital information to make decisions about building community centers, opening businesses, and planning for the future.



Responding also fulfills your civic duty because it's mandated by the U.S. Constitution. The United States has counted its population every 10 years since 1790.



Your responses are used to redraw legislative districts and determine the number of seats your state has in the U.S. House of Representatives.

Is my information safe?

Your responses to the 2020 Census are safe, secure, and protected by federal law. Your answers can only be used to produce statistics. They cannot be used against you by any government agency or court in any way—not by the FBI, not by the CIA, not by the DHS, and not by ICE.

When can I respond to the census?

In early 2020, every household in America will receive a notice to complete the census online, by phone, or by mail. In May, the U.S. Census Bureau will begin following up in person with households that have yet to respond.

What will I be asked?

You will be asked a few simple questions, like age, sex, and the number of people who live in your home, including children.

What won't be asked?

The census will never ask for Social Security numbers, bank or credit card numbers, money or donations, or anything related to political parties.

Understanding Stormwater


Some Things You Can Do to Prevent Stormwater Pollution

- Use fertilizers sparingly and sweep up driveways, sidewalks and gutters.
- Never dump anything down storm drains or in streams.
- Vegetate bare spots in your yard.
- Compost your yard waste.
- Use least toxic pesticides, follow labels, and learn how to prevent pest problems.
- Direct downspouts away from paved surfaces; consider a rain garden to capture runoff.
- Take your car to the car wash instead of washing it in the driveway.
- Check your car for leaks and recycle your motor oil.
- Pick up after your pet.

How to Register for CodeRED Alerts Online

Select Managed Account Preference

Creating a managed account will allow you access to modify your existing notification settings and contact information, below is a list of your options:

1. SINGLE SIGN-ON ACCOUNT

To create a single sign-on account, click the button next to “Yes” and click the corresponding logo to the credentials you would like to use, either Google, Facebook or Twitter. You will be prompted to log into your account to permit access.

2. MANAGED ACCOUNT

To create a managed account, click the button next to “Yes” and create a username and password. Please be sure to record this information for later use. *(username: 6 characters or more, password: 8)*

3. NON-MANAGED ACCOUNT

You will not have another option to create an account later in the form, or have the ability to log back in and update your contact information at a later date.

You must check the box if you would like to keep your information private.

Verify Information →

Press button to verify your information.

Confirmation Screen →

Once completed, you will receive a confirmation email (only if you created a managed account). It contains your account details, along with information regarding the CodeRED Mobile Alert app.

- **Caller ID** – Add the numbers listed to your phone’s contact list.
- **CodeRED Mobile Alert app** – Download the FREE app to receive safety notifications as you travel to stay informed.

Ordinance #66 Section VI

Trimming of Trees and Other Plants Along and Above Sidewalks


...it is the duty of occupants and owners at all times to keep hedges, bushes, shrubbery and trees trimmed as not to obstruct the sidewalk...or the view of motorists along intersecting streets

...limbs of trees shall be deemed an obstruction if they are permitted to overhang the sidewalk at a **height of less than seven (7) feet...**

Borough Officials are actively enforcing the Ordinance.

Dog Walking & Pet Waste Reminders



Residents are reminded that Ordinance No. 40 mandates that dog owners collect and properly dispose of feces deposited by their dog on any public or private property within the Borough of Seven Fields.

Section 4 of the ordinance states, in part, "*Feces must be picked up immediately by the dog owner and disposed of in the owner's refuse receptacle.*"

In addition to being a violation of the ordinance, leaving dog feces behind is a safety hazard. According to the EPA, dog feces is as toxic to the environment as chemical and oil spills.

Please note that pets are NOT permitted in the Town Park. This includes the entire park, playground, pool, ballfields, etc. Pets are also not permitted at any Borough sponsored events held at the Town Park, i.e. the carnival, food truck nights, etc.

Individuals are encouraged to report violators by calling 9-1-1.
