Fire Safety during Winter Storms


Winter storms can happen almost anywhere. They can cause us problems. Know what to do before, during and after a storm. This will help keep you and your family safe from a winter fire.

- Test all smoke alarms. Do this at least once a month. This way you will know they are working. Install carbon monoxide alarms in your home. Test the alarms.
- Plan two ways out of the home in case of an emergency. Clear driveway and front walk of ice and snow. This will provide easy access to your home.
- Make sure your house number can be seen from the street. If you need help, firefighters will be able to find you.
- Be ready in case the power goes out. Have flashlights on hand. Also have battery-powered lighting and fresh batteries. Never use candles.
- Stay aware of winter weather. Listen to the television or radio for updates. Watch for bulletins online.
- Check on neighbors. Check on others who may need help.
- Generators should be used outdoors. Keep them away from windows and doors. Do not run a generator inside your garage, even if the door is open.
- Stay away from downed wires. Report any downed wires to authorities.
- Be ready if the heat stops working. Use extra layers of clothes and blankets to stay warm. If you use an emergency heat source, keep anything that can burn at least 3 feet away.
- Turn portable heaters off when you leave the room. Turn them off when you go to bed.

IMPORTANT REMINDER

There are more home fires in winter than in any other season. Half of all home heating fires happen in December, January and February.

As you stay cozy and warm this winter season, be fire smart!

**Reminders from the
 Public Works Department
 of the Borough of Seven Fields**



- If a fire hydrant is located on your property, please keep it free and clear of heavy snow.
- On-street parking is not permitted on any of the Borough streets between the hours of 2:00 a.m.—6:00 a.m.
- On-street parking is completely prohibited in the townhouse neighborhoods. It is very important that the roads be free of parked vehicles when the plows are trying to clear the roads of snow before the morning rush hour.
- During heavy snowfalls, your patience is requested. Main roads must receive priority.
- If you witness a very dangerous snow condition that you feel needs immediate attention, dial 911. The 911 operators will contact the proper authorities to have the snow plow dispatched to that area.
- Please do not work against the snow plow operator's efforts. **When you shovel your driveway and sidewalk, do not throw the snow out into the streets.**

SNOW AND ICE REMOVAL FROM SIDEWALKS

As winter is here and snowfall is unpredictable, it's important to be prepared. Working together we can keep our community safe.

Ordinance #66, Section II outlines the requirements for snow & ice to be removed from sidewalks. Noncompliance will result in a warning notice being issued, in accordance with **Ordinance #81**, including a \$25 administrative fee.

The owner, occupant or tenant of every property fronting upon or located alongside any street in the Borough of Seven Fields is hereby required to remove or cause to be removed from all the sidewalks abutting upon such property, all snow or ice thereon fallen or formed.

Within twenty-four (24) hours after the snow shall have ceased to fallen or to have formed.

The snow and ice removed from the sidewalk shall not be dumped or piled onto any public street or alley.

COMMUNITY CENTER RENOVATIONS ARE UNDERWAY!!!!



Stay Safe in Cold Weather

The coldest months of the year are already here. Learn how to fight off some of the risks associated with winter's chill.

Don't underestimate cold weather

Check both the temperature and the wind chill before heading outdoors. Wind chill indicates how the air feels on your skin. It can vary dramatically from the actual temperature. Low wind chills and cold temperatures can have dangerous effects on your body, such as frostbite and hypothermia.

Frostbite occurs when parts of your body freeze from prolonged exposure to cold. Warning signs include: numbness and skin that's white or grayish-yellow and unusually firm or waxy.

Hypothermia sets in when your body is losing heat faster than it can produce it. There are several stages of hypothermia, but common symptoms include: uncontrollable shivering, memory loss, disorientation, slurred speech and drowsiness.

Victims with frostbite or hypothermia should receive immediate medical attention.

Bundle Up

If you must venture outside, layer up! Wear wool, silk or polypropylene inner layers and a tightly woven or wind-resistant outer layer. Finish off with the essentials: a hat, water-resistant boots, and gloves or mittens. Remove layers as you warm up as sweat can aid in heat loss.

Preparation is one of the best defenses against extreme cold.

Winter Mailbox Damage

The Borough of Seven Fields will not repair or replace mailboxes or posts that are damaged or fall over from the force of plowed snow and are not hit directly by the plow.

Mailboxes and supporting posts must be strong enough and installed in such a way to withstand the weight and force of snow removal including the force of snow pushed from the streets onto the side of the road.
